# Adding the Suffix -ous

I can use and spell words correctly with the suffix -ous.



Spelling Rule	Example Words
-our is changed to -or before -ous is added.	humorous
A final e of the root word must be kept if the word ends in ge.	outrageous
If there is an l sound before the -ous ending, it is usually spelt as l. A few words have an e.	obvious hideous
Sometimes there is no obvious root word.	enormous
