<p>Thursday 21st January</p>	<p>To be able to practice and recite surah Al-Aadiyaat & Surah Al-Alaq fluently and accurately.</p>	<p>Task 1: Year 1- Click on the link for Surah Al-Aadiyaat. Whilst listening, follow from verse 1-5 carefully on the screen and recite it along the way until the end. This should be done at least 'FIVE' times. Once confident, read to parent/sibling. (spend 20 mins on this task) Now try your best to repeat the verses without looking.</p> <p>Year 2- Click on the link for surah Al-Alaq. Whilst listening, follow each verse carefully on the screen and recite it along the way until the end. This should be done at least two times. Once confident, read to parent/sibling.
