Before we watch the story of the Rainbow Fish let's listen to our Nursery Rhyme.






However if you would like to do some writing and have a challenge then go to the next slide....


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CHALLENGE:

Think about where he lives and what he is like in the story - How did he help the Rainbow fish?


Have a go at writing your ideas around the Octopus.


