Once you have completed these words, please practice spelling out the word of the week.

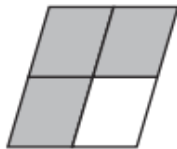
Our word of the week is **charge**

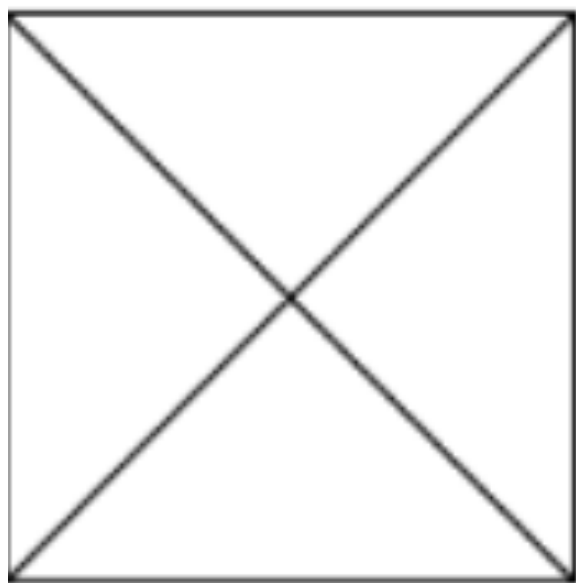
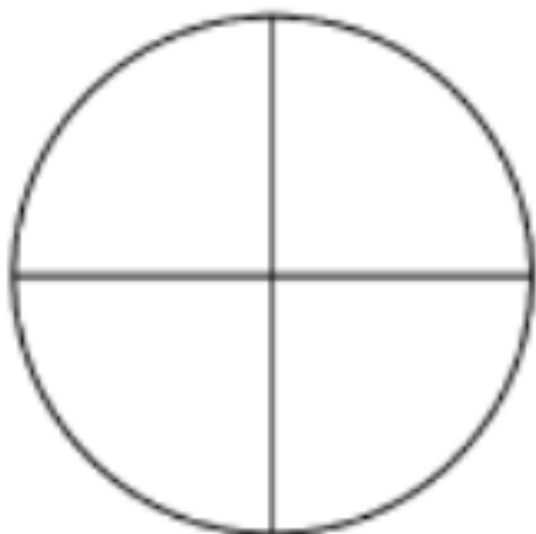

Can you sort these shapes into the correct column?

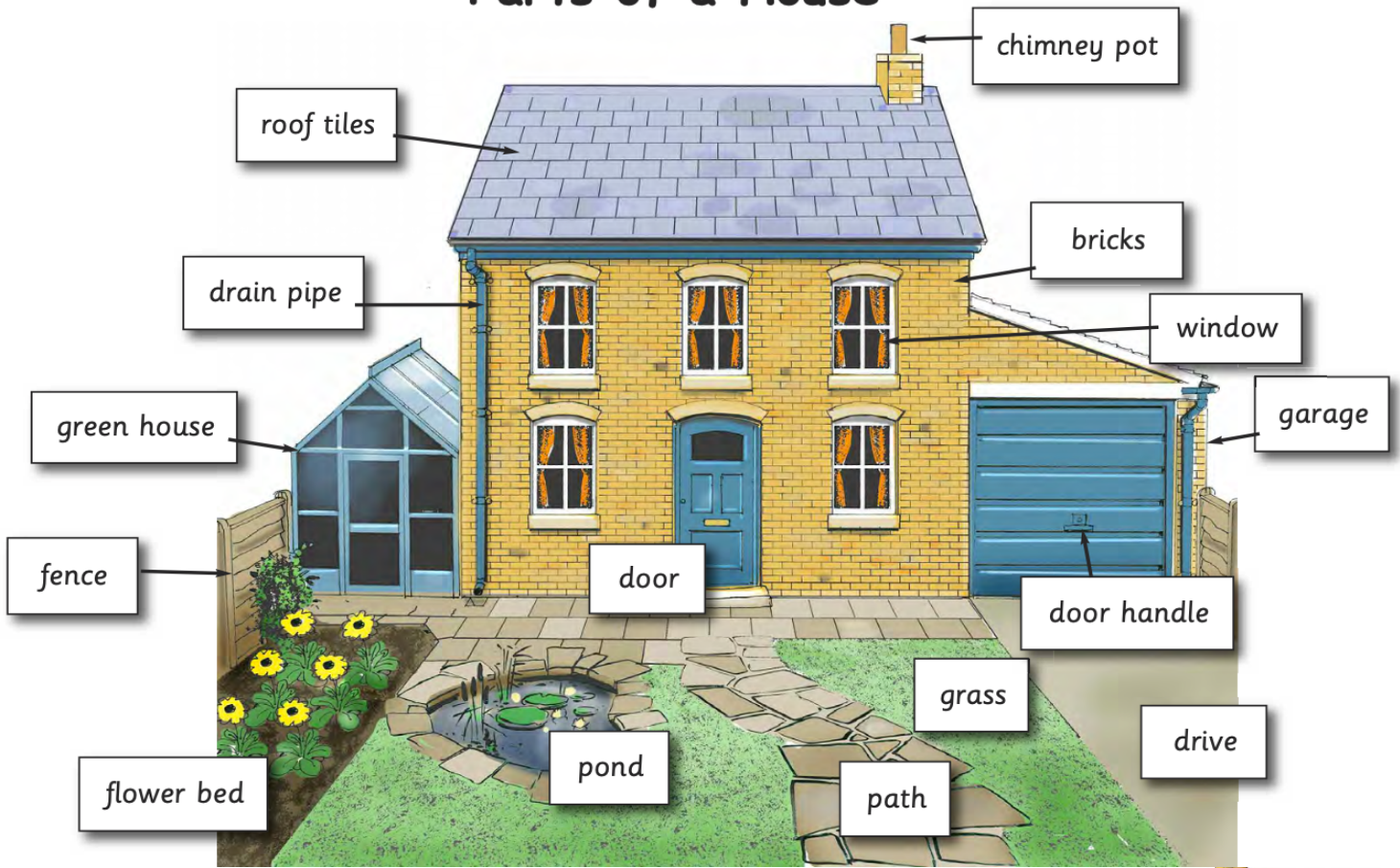
