Definition: Giving the impression that something bad is going to happen.

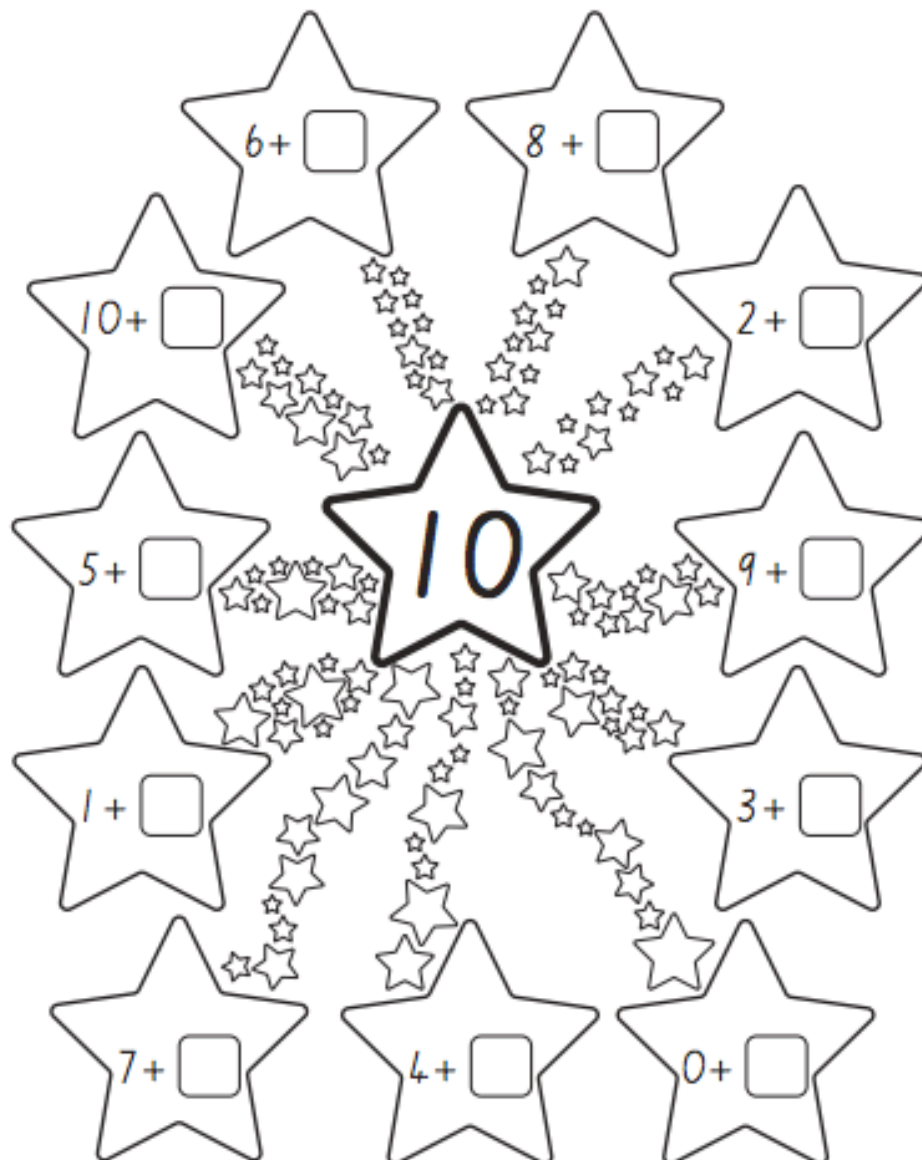
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This week in maths, year 1 have been learning about number bonds to 10. Here are some missing parts, we would like you to have a go at filling them in.

Star Number Bonds to 10

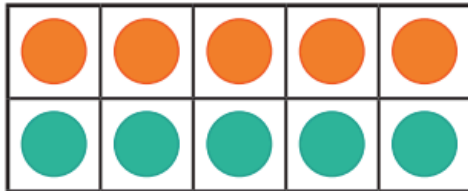

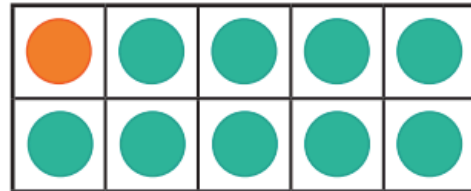

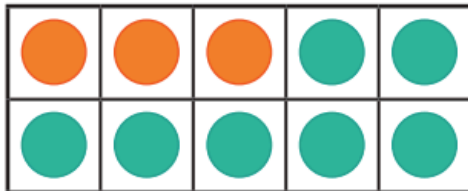
Number Bonds to 10 Ten-Frames



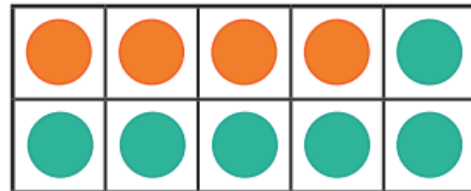
