Definition: a loud noise being repeated as an echo.

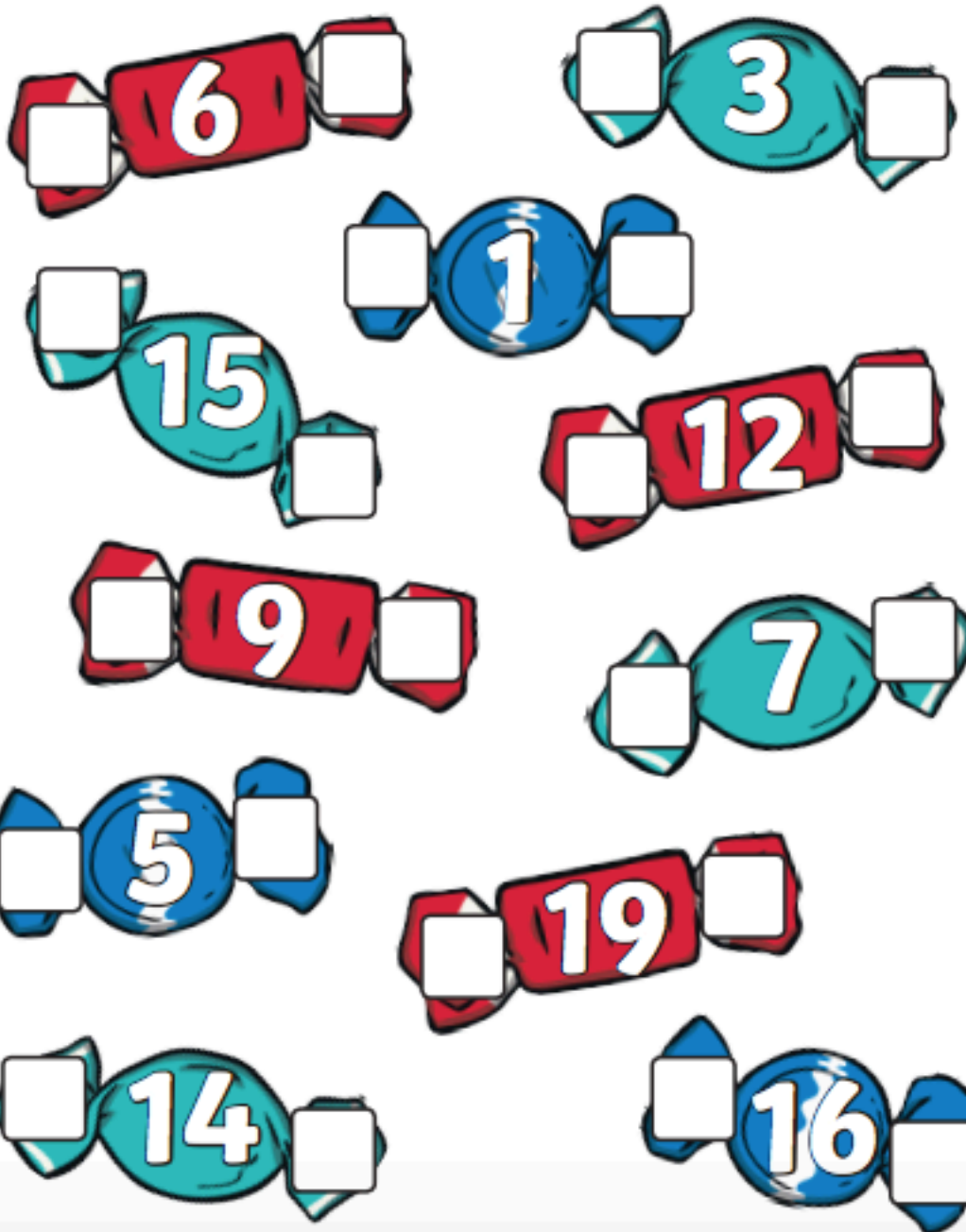
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This week in maths, year 1 have been focusing on counting in tens, and one more/less than a number.
