


English Homework

She had an accident at the factory.


DT Homework-Packaging

As part of your DT homework, I would like you to create 3D nets.


On the following slides are different 3D nets that you can create. You can print these out or if you don't have a printer, you can draw them on a piece of paper and then cut them out.

For this activity, you need scissors and a glue stick.




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
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
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History Homework-Romans Settlers and Invaders
