

Summer 2 Curriculum Overview 2022

KS2 - YEAR 5-6

Islamic knowledge is incorporated into the curriculum

English

This is Me

In English children will explore and reflect on their time at primary school and record some of their favourite memories. They will think about themselves and their own successes and achievements, big or small, as well as how they can help others achieve their own successes. They will engage in writing an autobiography, non-chronological reports, letters to themselves, playscripts and poems around the topic of 'This is Me'.

Islamic Link: We will consider our various blessings, our journey into this life and the spiritual journey to Allah that we are on. We will then relate and connect to the various names of Allah that relate to these blessings such as: Ar – Rahman, Al Quddus, Ar Razzaq, Ar – Rashid, Al Hadiy, Al – Mughniy, and Al-Barr

Maths

This Half-Term, students will continue to revise previously covered topics (Recovery Sessions), whilst learning a variety of new topics:

- Line graphs (Read, draw, and use)
- Measure with a protractor
- Introduce angles
- Compare and order angles
- Volume - counting cubes, estimate volume, volume of a cuboid
- Estimate capacity
- Consolidate volume
- Consolidation of statistics

Science

In Summer 2 science, children will be learning about how young children grow and develop, the changes that occur during puberty as well as discovering about the changing needs of humans during old age

Islamic Link

Hadith on when children reached puberty, they need to be regular and punctual with their salah.

PE

In PE this half-term, children will be learning Athletic skills such as: Running and Walking, running over Obstacles, throwing for distance, throwing for accuracy.

Islamic link: Health is very important in Islam, and we are instructed to take care of ourselves and keep healthy through good eating, movement, and exercise

Art

This half term children will be learning about performing arts. They will create artifacts for their end of year performance. They will also rehearse different performances.

Islamic Link: Do not draw images that may hurt someone's feelings or sentiments
Muslims have their own music (Nasheed)

History

During Summer 2, students will be learning about the greatest ship ever built – The Titanic!
Children will investigate and explore the famous Titanic through a variety of discussion topics as well as some key facts. From finding out who was on board the Titanic to how and why she sank.

Islamic Link: Allah taught the human how to build ships and use it as a means of transport. Prophet Nuh was the first human to build a ship to save his people and the living environment.

PSHE - Making Decisions

For Summer 2, children will tackle the sensitive topic of transition to new phases in their lives and the need to make sensible decisions. We will explore and discuss essential life changing topics such as: addiction, smoking, drugs, gangs, and criminal behaviour.

Islamic Link: Islam forbids anything that harms your body and soul. "Satan only wants to cause between you animosity and hatred through intoxicants and gambling and to avert you from the remembrance of Allah and from prayer. So will you not desist? [Quran: 5:91] This Aayah (verse) tells us how it is a detestable act of Satan, because intoxicants, in addition to sowing the seeds of enmity, prevent one from the remembrance of Allah.
