English

The children will be reading 'The Matchstick Diary' by Paul Fleishman as their study book. The story is about a grandfather who tells stories of his life to his granddaughter through objects he collected since he was a small boy.

The story touches on important themes such as migration, immigration and discrimination.

Outcomes: They will learn new vocabulary, they will write a non-chronological report, dialogue, a diary entry, mini autobiography, ship's log and re-tell the story (oral dictation).

Islamic link:

- The story of the migration will be linked to the Prophet's migration.
- The concept of diaries will be linked to the Kiraman Kaatibeen.

PE

They will be learning about team building skills to help reinforce their skills with their peers.

Autumn 1 Curriculum Overview 2022-23

KS2 - YEAR 3/4

Islamic knowledge is incorporated into the curriculum

Maths

This half-term Year 3/4 children will be learning about how to read, write, order and compare numbers. The children will be focusing on place value. Some of the topics will include:

- Recognising the value of three- and four-digit numbers.
- Ordering numbers from smallest to largest
- Partitioning numbers in 100s 10s and 1s.
- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division.
- The children will be learning advanced and efficient methods of using all four operations.

Islamic Link:

Numbers in the Quran: Ayahs, Surahs & pages of the Quran.

DT

Children will be investigating a range of packaging and they will explore the use of graphics on packaging. They will design a packaging box for a particular purpose and evaluate the finished product.

<u>Science Link:</u>

Different types of packaging for different purposes of food for example unhealthy/healthy food and different materials.

Science

The children will be learning about 'Health and Movements'. They will identify animals, including humans, need the right types and amounts of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. They will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Islamic Link:

Allah is Al-Musawwir: The Fashioner. He is the One who forms and shapes all.

Allah is Ar-Razzaq- The provider.

History

In History, the children will be learning about Roman invaders and settlers who came to Britain. They will look at how the Roman army made it possible to conquer Britain. They will find out how the army was organised, what a Roman soldier wore, and some of the strategies and techniques they used.

The children will consider some of the reasons for which people leave their homes to live in another place.

Islamic link:

 Migration/Hijrah: Our beloved Prophet migrated from Makkah to Madinah.

PSHE

Our topic of PSHE will be based on 'Feelings'. The children will be learning about different emotions and they will learn how to manage and cope with those emotions.

Islamic Link: Stories of the Prophet Muhammad and how he felt when he experienced different events in his lifetime.
