# Handout about the changes to the teaching of Phonics and Reading

This handout is a summary from the parent session that was ran this week, it will inform you of the coming changes to phonics and reading.

All schools are now recommended to choose a *validated* phonics scheme provided by the DfE. At Kingsfield we have chosen *Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised*, which is a systematic and synthetic phonics programme. We start teaching phonics in Nursery/Reception and follow the *Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised* progression, which ensures children build on their growing knowledge of the alphabetic code, mastering phonics to read and spell as they move through school.

### **Little Wandle**



Much of Little Wandle phonics is very similar to what we have previously done, it is the reading aspect that has the exciting changes.

#### What Little Wandle provides for our children at Kingsfield:

#### Daily phonics lessons in Reception and Year 1

We teach phonics for 30 minutes a day. In Reception, we build from 10-minute lessons, with additional daily oral blending games, to the full-length lesson as quickly as possible. Each Friday, we review the week's teaching to help children become fluent readers.

#### Differentiated for those working above or those working below expected.

Those working above will be targeted through higher level questioning and higher level reading books. For those requiring additional support, daily keep up will be provided and more intense catch up intervention for those that require it 3 x a week.

#### Teaching reading: Reading practice sessions three times a week

This is the biggest change to what you currently expect from Kingsfield. Children <u>will</u> <u>not</u> be heard on a 1-1 basis every other week if they are receiving Little Wandle. **Instead,** children will have 3 teaching reading sessions a week.

Each reading practice session has a clear focus, so that the demands of the session do not overload the children's working memory. The reading practice sessions have been designed to focus on three key reading skills:

Decoding: sounding out and blending to read.Prosody: teaching children to read with understanding and expression.Comprehension: teaching children to understand the text.

At the end of the week a post will go onto your child's EvidenceMe explaining what they have learnt that week and anything they may of particularly focused on will be shared and explained.

1-1 reading will be done once every six weeks to check in with your child during the assessment week. A comment will be made in the home school links book, this will also comment on the home reading that has taken place over the last 6 weeks. A reward system is going to be put into place, explained over leaf).

## What will come home with your child and what will the communication about reading look like?

 $\checkmark$  They will read 3 times a week in small groups of no more than 6

✓ The book they read will be sent home as an EBook to share and show off! This will be sent via EvidenceMe and will have a commentary of what they covered and learnt that week. *If you are not set up don't worry we are on it*!

 $\checkmark$  A decodable book of a similar level will be sent home (importance of practical handling of books)

✓ A library book to share will go home

✓ These 2 books will be changed on a set day, once a week

Every 6 weeks, the end of each half term – class teachers will check in with the physical book band going home and change if necessary. They will also respond to the home reading that has taken place. **X** 1-1 reading and teacher comments will not be as frequent, they will be every 6 weeks.

#### Once your child has become a fluent reader and no longer requires to receive Little Wandle they will have the following reading provision:

➤ Guided reading once every 2 weeks (recorded on Evidence Me and parent shared)

- >1-1 reading once every 2 weeks (recorded in home school links book)
- ► ERICA

➤ Library book weekly

> School book band book (changed as required by children)

> Looking into Rising Stars online for KS2 and those children in Y2 who have met the phonic standard.
