People first started working on connecting computers in the 1960s.





In the 1970s, people created electronic mail, or 'email'. This was a way to send digital letters to each other.

By the 1990s, the World Wide Web was invented. This is a collection of pages, or 'websites'. Each website holds different information. People all over the world can look at the websites.





You need a router to connect to the Internet. The router sends a signal to your device. This signal lets you see words, pictures and videos.

You can access the Internet on a desktop computer, laptop, tablet, smart TV, games console or smartphone.
